Cross media publishing with Java and XML standards

This workshop gives an overview about the capabilities of XML languages and concepts like XSLT, XSL-FO, DOM, SAX and SVG and how to utilize them for cross media publishing purposes.

Managing corporate identity compliant web applications with Cocoon and SVG

This workshop illustrates the advantages of XML-based creation and management of web design elements. We explain how to use XML technologies to define and implement layout guidelines (e.g., corporate identities) and manage layout parameters for cross media publishing in an efficient way.
